1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

3. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or

## 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

## 2. Forms of EMD and PBG

- ii. Monthly invoice bill = Rs. [A + C \* (Actual km run in a month as per log book)]
- iii. Consignee shall ensure that the bill raised by service provider is as per the ATC. Necessary penalty and deductions shall be deducted before approval of invoice in GeM. In all other cases, invoice shall be summarily rejected.

iv. Subsequent to invoice approval, online payment shall be made to service providers as per GeM SLA and ATC for invoice amount.

3. PVC is not applicable to the tender.

4. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned

copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

5. Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by 14 days written notice to the Seller, if:

(i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.

(ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s)/Service or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.

(iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s)/Service or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s)/Service promptly.

(iv)The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.

(v)The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors . (vi)A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.

(vii)The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

6. Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation; court receivership or similar proceedings should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

7. **ELIGIBILITY conditions in addition to GeM conditions:**

i) AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER: An office of the Service Provider must be located **within the state of Consignee**. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO BE SUBMITTED (i.e., MSE certificate, UDM, Udyam, Gumaasta, GST certificate, PAN card of firm etc). Self-Declaration/Kiraynama will not be considered. Firm must submit document, otherwise their offer will be summarily rejected.

ii) Vehicle should be registered in the name of Tenderer and should not sublet any part of the contract. However, the Tenderer can have Lease Agreement with the owner of the vehicle/cab aggregator on non-judicial stamp paper for the tenure of the contract, which should be submitted along with the bid. The Tenderer is required to submit the Vehicle registration details along with supporting documents of the vehicle fulfilling the category, specifications etc. otherwise their offer will be summarily rejected.

iii) The vehicle supplied should be registered with TAXI/MAXI/CAB/Transport Permit. Bids of other than commercial vehicles should be summarily rejected. & **UNDER 7.5 TON MUV PICKUP VAN is exempted from permit. Fitness certificate will be required if MUV pickup is older than 2 years**

iv)It should have "Valid Fitness certificate/commercial license" (Permit for Commercial Vehicle shall cover all States in S.E.C. Railway jurisdiction or as considered necessary by the Department/ Division/ Unit calling the tender from appropriate Regional Road Transport Authority of the concerned State Govt./Union Territory), valid insurance and should meet requirements of pollution standard etc. as per provisions of Motor Vehicle Act and fulfil any other statutory obligations as applicable including all safety approved accessories/ equipment fitted to the vehicle. Driver should possess a valid driving license, Aadhar Card on his name and

d employee identification card issued by the Contractor at all times. Consignee will ensure compliance of this condition.

v) The vehicle proposed to be offered on hire should be in good condition and not more than 2 years old, on the date of opening of tender excluding the year of tender opening (i.e., if tender opening date is 10-05-2023 then vehicle registered on from 01-01-2021 up to 10-05-2023 will be eligible).

vi) **Financial criteria:** The tenderers will be qualified only if they have minimum financial capabilities as below:

**A). T1 - Financial Turnover:** The bidder should have an aggregate financial turnover not less than 1.5 times the advertised Bid value during the last three previous financial years and in the current financial year up to the date of opening of the tender. The audited balance reflecting financial turnover certified by chartered accountant with her stamp, signature and membership number shall be considered.

**B). T2 - Liquidity:** The bidder should have access to or has available liquid assets, lines of credit and other financial means to meet cash flow that is valued at 5% of the estimated bid value net of applicant's commitments for other contracts. The audited balance sheet and/or banking reference certified by chartered accountant with stamp, signature and membership number shall be submitted by the bidder along with bid.

Banking reference should contain in clear terms the amount that bank will be in a position to lend for this work to the applicant/member of the Joint Venture/Consortium. In case the Net Current Assets (as seen from Balance Sheet) are negative, only the Banking references will be considered. Otherwise, the aggregate of the Net Current Assets and submitted Banking references will be considered for working out the Liquidity.

The banking reference should be from a Scheduled bank in India and it should not be more than 3 months old as on date of submission of bids.

In case of JV firms' overall liquidity of JV firm shall be assessed by arithmetic sum of liquidity of all members of JV.

**vii) Work Experience:** The bidder should have satisfactorily completed\* in the last three previous financial years and the current

8. Duration of the service contract may be extended up to 6 months beyond the initial contract duration (subject to satisfactory performance and mutual consent).

9. PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND WAGES: Service Provider is required to pay Salaries / wages of contracted staff deployed at buyer location first i.e., on their own and then claim payment from Buyer along with all statutory levies/duties.

10. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase the quantity (number of months of operation) to be ordered up to 25 percent at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity (number of months of operation) during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

11. Successful Bidder can submit the **Performance Security @5%** in the form of FDR/Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR/DD should be made in favour of FA&CAO/S ECR/Bilaspur payable at SBI. After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the FDR/DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original FDR/DD to the User within 30 days of award of contract.

12. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regard. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of q

quoted GST %.

13. All Hired vehicles should be equipped with prescribed emergency medical kit and a fire extinguisher as per statutory provisions.

14. The vehicle should be available on all days including holidays.

15. A Log Book for each vehicle shall be maintained by the Contractor for the hired vehicles. The KM utilized shall be entered in it on daily basis to ensure proper accountal and payment at the end of every month/specified period.

16. One weekly off is permitted to the driver normally on Sundays however it may be differed to some other day at the discretion of the officer in charge to whom the vehicle is attached.

17. Normal working hours may be advised by user department however the vehicle shall be available for all 24 hours for use as and when required. The driver of the vehicle shall keep himself in contact with the officer in charge.

18. The vehicle supplied should be neat clean and in good fettle the driver must be well dressed and in white or grey uniform.

19. Mobile phone should be provided to the vehicle driver with smart handset.

20. As and when required by officer vehicle can also be utilized for travelling outstation i.e., more than 50 Km.

21. Vehicle required to be parked at officer's residence or office premises.

22. **PENAL Clause:** In addition to clauses mentioned in GeM SLA clause No. 8 and others, following will apply: -

Vehicle must have minimum 200 km range /20 Litres fuel available on each service providing day to avoid service interruption. Failing to above condition will be treated as not availability of services and to be dealt as per the existing penalty clause available in GEM i.e., SLA clause No. 8(7) of GeM contract/Special conditions of contract.

The changed vehicle is in the same segment as specified in agreement before forwarding vehicle bill to accounts department for internal check the above points to be invariably complied by executive department.

31. All the papers submitted should be sign by the bidder.

8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
